**ASIFA**, *Association International du Film d'Animation* (International Animated Film Association) was founded in France in 1960 and chartered under UNESCO, the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization with the goals of encouraging the art of animation and furthering international goodwill through the medium. With chapters worldwide, including nine in the United States, **ASIFA**

**International** sanctions a variety of international animation festivals, publishes an informative magazine and facilitates a variety of programs for animators, educators and students. The International maintains a website at [asifa.net](http://asifa.net).

**ASIFA/Central**, the Midwestern USA Chapter, was founded by a group of Chicago area animators in 1975 and has grown to encompass members from Texas to Michigan. 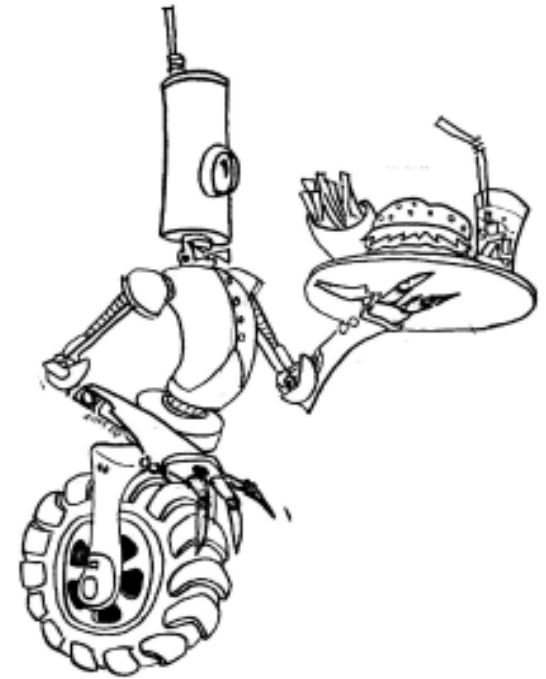
